## Eligibility Requirements:

- Eligible Participants Must Be:
  - Unemployed for 6+ months,
  - English language learner,
  - Age 55 or older,
  - Individual with a disability, or
  - Honorably discharged veteran
- Minimum 6 college credits in Early Childhood Education (12 credits preferred)
- Must be available to work at least 30 hours per week, Monday–Friday
- Willing to travel up to 15 miles
- Must be 18 years or older
- Social Security Card
- Valid CA ID/Drivers License or Valid U.S. Passport
- Valid Permanent Resident Card or Valid Employment Authorization (if not U.S. citizen)
- Selective Service Registration (Males only born on/after 01/01/60)
- Additional documents may be requested depending on program requirements
