Who Can Apply for the ESE Program?

- Adults unemployed for 6+ months,
- English language learners,
- Adults ages 55 or older,
- Young adults ages 18–24 who are out of school and unemployed,
- Individuals with a disability, or
- Honorably discharged veterans

Eligibility Requirements

- Minimum 6 college credits in Early Childhood Education (12 credits preferred)
- Must be available to work at least 30 hours per week, Monday–Friday
- Willing to travel up to 15 miles
- Must be 18 years or older
- Social Security Card
- Valid CA ID/Drivers License or U.S. Passport
- Valid Permanent Resident Card or Employment Authorization (if not U.S. citizen)
- Selective Service Registration (Males only born on or after 01/01/60)
- Additional documents may be requested
